## **Dreaming of making a labyrinth?**

DC Donohue, labyrinth artist, and one of the founding members of LNN is making labyrinths again after a hiatus of several years. This summer she drew the new labyrinth at St. James Lutheran in Portland and the new labyrinth at Marylhurst University. Russell Hill assisted DC, and both labyrinths were painted by volunteers. DC has experience with portable canvas labyrinths and temporary labyrinths as well as permanent labyrinths. So, if you're thinking about creating a labyrinth, now would be a good time to take action.
