The labyrinth community in Portland is grieving the sudden unexpected loss of Ann Schneider who was a beloved leader of several labyrinth groups in Portland.

Ann was a founding member of Labyrinth Network Northwest and served on the LNN Planning Circle for many years. Ann was especially interested in dance, and she planned and danced in the opening ceremony for the first Northwest Regional Labyrinth Gathering in 2006 and presented an LNN workshop on Dance and the Labyrinth in 2008.

Ann's work on planning and preparations for many labyrinth events in the Portland area continued until the time of her death.

Ann was a leader of the Labyrinth Guild of Grace Memorial Episcopal Church, Portland, OR and The Trinity Labyrinth Guild at Trinity Episcopal Cathedral in Portland.

Ann Schneider's Memorial Service at Trinity Episcopal Cathedral in Portland on November 16 was overflowing with Ann's friends from the community groups which she supported. Anne worked with many different projects to help immigrants and children, and she was also a supporter of many different art groups. Her memorial service reflected all those interests. It was a glorious celebration.

Ann's generosity was widespread, and I encourage all of you to read her full obituary. It's an inspiration to all of us.
